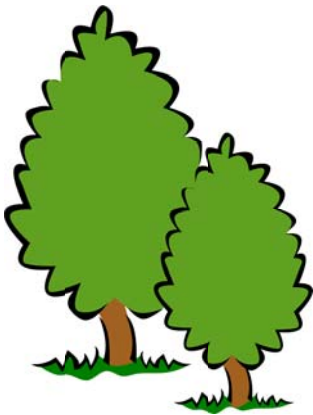


Tree Disputes – Student Helpdesk
